# Message from Pastor Kris

A component of State Line UMC's vision is to help people **grow** in **their faith**, so we exist as a church to help people deepen and expand their journey with Jesus. In the months to come, I'm going to highlight six different marks of discipleship in my newsletter messages to you based on the book *The Disciple Making Church* written by Glenn McDonald.

According to McDonald, the first mark of an authentic disciple is a heart for Christ alone. Being a disciple means being an active follower and student of Jesus Christ. It is a person who is seeking to let Jesus be the leader of their life, rather be their own leader. A couple of years ago I came behind a car and I noticed this bumper sticker: Galileo was wrong; the world revolves around ME. This certainly made me laugh the day I saw it. But over the years I wondered about this phrase as a Christian. For a disciple of Jesus Christ, the world does not revolve around me. Instead, the world should revolve around Jesus as Jesus should be the leader of all aspects of our life.

We must have a daily desire for the heart of Christ in our life. We should desire and seek to read and study scripture and pray to determine what the heart of Christ is like. As reflected in Jesus' words in John 15:5, "I am the vine, you are the branches. Those who abide in me and I in them bear much fruit, because apart from me you can do nothing." So I wonder: Who exactly is Jesus Christ to you, and have you chosen to become His disciple for the rest of your life? What is keeping you back from having a heart for Christ alone?


# Christ's Teachings
