# Message from Pastor Kris

Last month, I shared that each month in my newsletter articles I would be highlighting a new mark of discipleship. These unique marks of discipleship help us navigate and learn how we can deepen and **grow our faith** together as a community of faith! According to Glenn McDonald in his book *The Disciple Making Church*, the second mark of an authentic disciple is **having a mind transformed by the Word.** 

To be a person who loves Jesus, we first need to have a heart for Jesus and now have a mind that is being transformed by the Bible. Often a 20-30-minute sermon heard each Sunday with little to no Bible reading throughout the week stands very little chance often to create transformation in our lives. This is due to the wave of other influences that come up throughout our week. Advertising, sitcoms, billboards, the Internet, novels, infomercials, and talk radios promulgate a message that is often contrary to that of the Bible. Each year about 130,000 new books are published and television continues to be the dominant medium of popular culture. In light of this, the Bible has a chance to be lost in this forest of information and data.

Yet, to be a person who is seeking to follow after Jesus more, we are to be people who are transformed by the stories and words of the Scriptures. Paul challenges his readers in Romans 12:2: "Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind." Paul challenges followers of Jesus to be transformed by a renewing of the mind that can come through the Bible.

I invite you this month to seek to be transformed by reading of the Scriptures. The key is not to read for mere knowledge or information; rather, to become more like Christ and more filled with the life of God. To read the scriptures to allow it to shape your entire understanding of the world and choices. I invite you to ask yourself: how much time every week am I committing to personal spiritual development and Bible reading? How much time does God desire for me to commit? I invite you to list the priorities and activities that will need to shift in order to fulfill that call, sit down, and share your plan of action with someone else!
