Message from Pastor Kris

When was the last time you prayed for our church? When was the last time you opened up our church directory and prayed over the people from our church? Did you know that we do not have an official prayer team at State Line? Even though, prayer is one of our core values at our church, we do not have an official group of people who pray for our church on a regular basis.

Over the last few months, I have been praying about specific marks of an authentic disciple of Jesus Christ. This month, I want to highlight the power of prayer, and how we should have knees for prayer. Prayer is a notable practice, as it ushers us into the presence of the living God and creates space for a holy conversation. Yet, deep and authentic prayer is sometimes seldom a key aspect of our lives and seldom a main focus of churches. A disciple-making church, which is committed above all else to the imitation of Jesus, models itself upon the pervasiveness of his prayer life. Jesus chose to spend time alone with his Father before he made any major decisions and faced major challenges. Continuously, Jesus sought the wisdom, courage, and strength from his Father to sustain his public and private ministry with God's people.

Who wants to be the prayer champions of State Line UMC? Who wants to be the prayer champions of our children and youth and young adult ministry? Who wants to be the prayer champions for our community? Who wants to be the prayer champions of our outreach ministry? Who wants to be the prayer champions over our entire faith community? Churches that are able to make new disciples of Jesus Christ are churches that embed their entire ministry in prayer.
