#### Message from Pastor Kris

I assume that when you are reading this newsletter, it is near the beginning of July and Hannah and I have safely arrived in Kampala, Uganda! Hannah and I will be away from June 26 until July 13. This is the first time we have been on a mission trip together, and the first time I've been back to Uganda since 2012. Mission trip experiences are foundational to the Christian faith and built around the conviction to serve and share God's love with people around the world. (See Acts 1:8!)

During this mission trip, we will be building a playground for a local community located outside the capital of Kampala. This area is highly influenced by Islam and we will be ministering at Bwaise Pentecostal Church. This church is one of the most thriving places in this slum area. When we're not working on this playground, we will be leading women and men's Bible studies, leading puppet shows for children, making bricks in preparation of building a new secondary school, and visiting with the 300+ children sponsored through this school.

I plan to utilize Facebook and email to share with you all how God is at work and specific prayer requests. I truly covet your prayers for this trip.

Here are a few items to specifically pray for:

- Pray for the safety, health, and unity of our team of 15 adults. Pray that we will be *brave and strong* when sharing Christ and will allow the Holy Spirit to lead us.
- Pray for the old and new relationships that will be developed with this church community.
- Pray for the women's and men's Bible Study.
- Pray for the playground we will be installing.
- Pray for the service we will be leading and the puppet shows we will be doing.
- Pray that we will be able to make many bricks for the secondary school.
- Pray for our time with the sponsored children as we visit them.
- Pray that each day we see ourselves as servants of God and remain focused on serving God and our friends.

I'm grateful for the opportunity to represent Jesus Christ and State Line UMC on this mission experience.

- Reuse cups rather than taking a new one for refills.
- Bring your insulated water bottles/coffee mugs from home and take them along with you head home.

Small changes in our behavior are the beginning in caring for the home we've been given.
