Message from the Pastor

We have begun another year and some might even say a new decade. We can look back over the year and see the hurdles that we faced, some that we were able to overcome and some that will carry over for us. In the midst of life we face many trials but the scriptures tell us in Psalm 55 verse 22 "Cast your cares on the Lord and he will sustain you; he will never let the righteous be shaken." It asks God to make a breakthrough in our lives and in the life of our community here in State Line and use us as his instruments to bring new people to know him. 

Seven of us went to Mission Central to volunteer on January 25th. We did not know what we would be helping with until we arrived. Mission Central actually houses 8 different ministry's that share space. We took a tour and heard about each of the ministries that are not necessarily affiliated with the UMC. We heard how God has showed up by someone donating something and often in a few days someone calls with that need – OR – the need is presented & a few days later what is needed arrives. We started by sorting a few skids of books that will be distributed to other countries for learning. We helped sort and wrap blankets that will be given out to homeless people. There is always plenty of work that can be done there and if you missed it this time be sure to sign up for our next trip that we will schedule in the future.



CHURCH NEWS

December Leadership Team Meeting Highlights

January's Leadership Team meeting served as a follow-up to the group's January 11 retreat and planning session. A number of new initiatives, informative pieces, and scheduling were part of the meeting. Highlights follow:

Folders with guiding principles, facility use/agreement documents, Safe Sanctuaries policy and job descriptions were given to members. Review of these is to be done before February meeting with questions to be addressed then.

Anyone needing Safe Sanctuaries clearances update and training will be notified by Mary. This needs to be kept current to enable folks to work with children, youth, and vulnerable adults in church ministries and activities.

The parish house/rental property has new tenants. Thankfully they moved in without any lapse in rental income.

Pastor Steven presented information about four proposals for separation and continuation of the UMC relative to varying positions on the subject of LGBTQ issues that are dividing the denomination. A meeting with State Line members to explain the proposals will be offered closer to the mid-May General Conference date.

Team members completed a primary leadership components assessment to clarify each person's leadership style. Results will be tallied and shared at the next meeting.

Increasing both individual and corporate prayer life was discussed after a presentation by Pastor Steven. Offering meaningful prayer is important. A breakthrough prayer was agreed upon and practiced by the team. The prayer will be shared with and used by our congregation starting in the near future. Prayer is powerful; we need to be intentional about it.

A number of events/activities for 2020 can be found elsewhere in this newsletter. Hopefully this will aid everyone in keeping dates clear to participate as a church family.

Fifth Sunday Celebrations will occur in March, May, and August in the form of a meal after worship. Details will be given closer to each date.

The team agreed that the praise team leader position will be paid \$100 monthly to start in February.
