



## **CHURCH NEWS**

#### February Leadership Team Meeting Highlights

- After opening with lighting of the Spirit candle, singing, and prayer, Rob Socks shared "Walk by Faith" devotional.
- Linda Junkins presented a comprehensive look at the church's finances, explaining income and outflow along with providing a detailed list of routine items to be paid throughout the year. After a time for questions/answers, the team felt they had a better understanding of the church's financial situation. Giving of tithes and offerings is currently meeting needs. Self-discipline in giving is vital as obligations need to be met all year whether we are physically in church or not.
- Pastor Steven shared information to help team members understand their leadership styles and how to use them effectively with each other.
- Estimates will be sought to improve the East Avenue entrance to include addition of a handrail, address the uneven sidewalk, and replace doors with ones which are touch-activated for handicap accessibility. Funding will likely come from the Improvement Fund with donations accepted to repay the account rather than lower it significantly.
- Folks are needed to serve as worship assistants. Anyone interested should speak to Pastor Steven to be added to the schedule.
- New for 2020 5th Sunday Celebration Lunches. The first one will be March 29. Look for details in this newsletter.
- Grocery supplies are needed monthly for distribution at State Line Inn. Please remember to help out with this ongoing effort.
- Diapers, wipes, and diaper cream collection will run until March 15.
- Fingernail and/or toenail clippers will be collected between March 22 and April 5 in a way to help fill healthcare kits for Mission Central. Each district in the Susquehanna Conference has a different item to collect. Yes, Dollar Tree has clippers for you guessed it \$1.00!
- Julia Ware is currently serving as church custodian.
- The youth took part in a fundraiser on Feb. 23 by bowling with proceeds going to Cumberland Valley Breast Care Alliance.
- A church van use policy document was presented and adjusted to fit our needs. A logbook has been prepared and is in the van for use each time it is driven. Anyone wanting to be added to the list of eligible drivers should speak with Pastor Steven.

The next leadership team meeting is at 6:30 on March 17. All are welcome to attend. It's yet another way to be informed about the life of our church in addition to reading these highlights, bulletin announcements, and Facebook posts.
