Leadership Team Highlights

The Leadership Team met on August 20. A variety of topics were discussed and decisions were made. Following are some which may interest you.

*In the 'new people' category are Connie and Charlie (not a couple). A number of State Line Inn residents are interested in coming to worship if transportation can be provided. Here's a simple way to serve if you are able to pick up/take home a few folks. New members (who are not new to our church family) are Greg and Kayla Berkley, parents of Lincoln. We are blessed to have them all with us.

*Pastor Steven will have leadership development as his seminary focus and will bring that focus to our church and team.

*Worship assistants, band members, and acolyte are asked to meet in the office promptly at 10:00 a.m. each Sunday for the prayer huddle. This allows time for those folks to mingle with others during coffee fellowship time.

*Fall activities getting underway include a potential Bible study for couples, Pastor Ruth's Bible study, youth fellowship and the first free spaghetti dinner and praise night.

*Communication of church news was discussed. Announcements of 'all things church' are made in the weekly announcements via email and Sunday bulletin, monthly newsletters, church Facebook posts, church website and verbally prior to worship. We ask that each person tune in to what's happening in the way(s) that each finds best.

*Owning property is not without the unexpected. An example is the parsonage needing the installation of a new well pump after there was no water to be had. Other upkeep chores include the spraying (with future filling to come) of weedy cracks in the parking lot and the addition of a new downspout to handle runoff from the church roof.

*The budget was reviewed; we are still struggling to keep income and outflow even or possibly get a bit ahead. On the positive side, roughly \$3200 has been graciously given to repay the funds borrowed for AC replacement at the church.

*Clear your calendar for Sept. 15 at 5:00 to participate in the first free community spagnetti dinner with casual praise to follow at 6:30. Needed are folks to help cook, serve, clean up, EAT, and CONVERSE with folks from the community.

*Three openings on the leadership team need to be filled. A nominations team of 4 church members will be convened for this purpose. More info will follow soon.

*Our faithful financial servant, Linda Junkins, is stepping down from the position held since 2005. We are actively seeking a treasurer (handles bills/payroll, a variety of required financial reports) and a financial secretary (responsible for counting/recording/depositing offering weekly). Many thanks to Linda for her faithful, accurate, and timely service for about 15 years!

*Estimates to have the front doors replaced (originally part of our building improvement plan) will be gathered with work hopefully being done as soon as feasible dependent on cost and funds available. Several members will be working to transform the upstairs men's room to a family/unisex bathroom so it is handicap accessible. A \$300 donation from Hannah Sledge's grandparents gives some funds to start with. Changes will be minimal; it is hoped a wall-mount changing table can be included along with new door handles, a lock, and new signage. For more details, see a team member.
