Message from the Pastor

Dear State Line Church family,

Here we are and it is September. Who would have ever thought that church buildings across the country would be closed for an extended period of time? Throughout this pandemic I pray that you have been able to continue to trust God in your faith journey. I know it has been tough for everyone. God promises that he will never leave us or forsake us.

The weather has been wonderful over the past two months as we have gathered outside for worship. That is about to change with the season. We are planning to return to the building for worship on September 13th. The leadership team will continue to monitor recommendations and guidelines from our Conference and our government.

We do plan to only use the sanctuary at this time and will be addressing what will take place during our worship time together when we arrive that first Sunday. We ask that you continue to have an open mind and remember that patience and understanding is appreciate as we continue to figure out what needs to be adjusted as we move forward. We will continue to live stream to Facebook and put a recording on YouTube for those who may not be able to or choose not to worship in person at this time.

Romans chapter 14:19 "Let us therefore make every effort to do what leads to peace and to mutual edification." This specific verse is talking about what food is considered clean or unclean, but the chapter is talking about God's grace and how we should treat others and how we live out our own faith journey as we do not cause other to stumble. Let us focus on the positives and be gentle with our own personal thoughts and desires as we proceed with caution. Are we willing to be part of the solution and not cause more problems?

- 1. Wear a mask
- 2. Please use hand sanitizer as you enter the sanctuary (mounted at both entrances of the sanctuary)
- 3. Doors will be open at 10am and not before
- 4. No Sunday school at least for the first few weeks.
- 5. Social distancing while in the building
- 6. Please go directly to a pew (every other pew will be blocked off)
- 7. THERE WILL BE NO SINGING AT THIS TIME. (re-evaluated weekly)
- 8. We will dismiss by rows and we ask that you exit the building and not linger inside.
- 9. Basement will be off limits for the time being.
- 10. There will be a team to sanitize the space after the service. (help would be appreciated)
- 11. Bring a positive attitude that shows we appreciate being back together in our building for worship.
- 12. Everything is subject to change (except your positive attitude)

Leadership Team Meeting Highlights

The Leadership Team was blessed with pleasant weather on the evening of August 18 and met in the yard to the east of the church. The following were discussed:

- The team agreed that worship near the band shell in Jerome R. King Playground has been a positive experience. This location will be utilized through Sept., 6. It was noted that if rain forces the service to be online only, members not using social media/email need to be called to alert them of the cancellation of gathering outdoors.
- Worship will be held in our sanctuary at 10:15 a.m. on Sept. 13th. Protocol will be shared with membership after finalization of necessary adjustments at a meeting to be held at 6:30 p.m. on Sun., Aug. 30.
- The sidewalk replacement/improvements at the street side of the church are underway. The handrail will be put in place after the concrete has dried and cured. As mentioned last month, a memorial donation will cover much of the project's cost. Donations from individuals are welcomed to help with the amount not covered by the donation.
- Consideration was given to developing a way we might be able to offer internet access at the church to students who don't have it at home. It was agreed to see what the need may be after school is in session for a few weeks.
- It was noted that a number of people's Safe Sanctuaries certification needs to be renewed. Anyone who helps with or may be interested in helping with children, youth, and/or vulnerable adults is required to have the clearances. See Mary Thomas in the church office to submit the information needed for the certification.
- Providing food to residents of the State Line Inn continues monthly. YOUR HELP IS NEEDED to provide food items and/or to pack and deliver the food to the Inn on the last Wednesday of the month. The food blesses those who receive it, and those who help with this outreach are blessed by seeing the joy it brings to the recipients. The next leadership team meeting will be held at 6:30 on Sept. 15. All are welcome to attend.
