August Leadership Team Meeting Highlights

Despite the on-going and widespread Covid cases, State Line UMC is on the upswing with new ministries getting underway, a special event being planned, and improvements being made. The following were part of the August 24 meeting agenda:

- Pastor Ruth is pleased with the increased planning and hope to become a 'full-service' church again. She gave a reminder of the importance of encouraging each other in our daily walks.
- Improvements in the past month have included the replacement of a section of roof above the church office, installation of a grinder pump to rectify a sewer issue, and placement of a new projector as the previous one's life was up. In mid-September, the church's front doors and shutter will be painted.
- Sept. 9 is the last date for payment of authorized items to be covered by the PPP loan. As always, our commitment to give/tithe is vital for our church's financial health.
- Ways are coming up in which you can participate in fellowship and/or spiritual growth. All adults are invited to the first Adult Fellowship meal and gathering on Sept. 24. A meal, Bible Outburst game, and planning will take place. On Sept. 25, an activity day for kids will be held in the parking lot. More details will be coming and **HELPERS WILL BE NEEDED**.
- Approved by the team were sale of some metal cabinets and miscellaneous items at an Aug. 28 yard sale and a \$500 donation from the Helping Hands Fund to Habitat for Humanity based on a request from Mark Story who represents that agency.
- Beginning in September, the Helping Hands/Noisy Collection, will resume. **Save your change** (and currency) to donate and **make a difference** as folks need assistance.
- Some ways you can be involved (watch for more info) include singing in our church choir, serving as a leader for the Sunday morning adult small group (starting in October), and attending future Leadership Team meetings.
