#### Be Faithful to our call

Mark 16:15, 'And He (Jesus) said to them, "Go into all the world and proclaim the Gospel to the whole creation."'

Where are you at with getting the Gospel to your friends, family, co-workers, and neighbors? Where are you with inviting people to Church services where they'll hear the whole counsel of God? God has called you and I to Go Proclaim the Gospel. Church, we have to make the first step. Over and over we're told in Scripture that evangelizing is part of what the church does.

What telling people the Gospel is about is about being honest with them; loving them enough to let them know the truth. It's about the fact that we've all broken God's law and wrath is being stored up against us for the day of wrath. For the wages of sin in death. It's about the fact that people are blinded & dead in their sin, that they love their sin, and that it keeps them a slave. It's about the fact that without death and resurrection of Christ, an eternal Hell awaits them. It's about telling them that if they call out to Jesus Christ, put their faith in Him and the work He did on the cross as well as rising from the dead, and repenting from their sin, they will be saved. It's about encountering the Triune God Who loves them, desires fellowship with them, spending eternity with them, and about people enjoying God and His presence in this life and the next. Your friends, family, co-workers, and neighbors need freedom that only Christ can provide and God has chosen you to proclaim the Gospel which will set them free.

We know that we are the mouthpieces for God; this is how He set up the plan for evangelism (*Romans 10*). Now God fully understands the type of culture in which we live and He understands the difficulty of getting the Gospel out, but we need to remember that the results are up to God and not us. God is the One Who saves, not us. However, it *is* up to us to actually pray for the lost, engage in friendships, ask people questions about their thoughts on the afterlife and God, and then give them the Gospel... while not forgetting the love and compassion of Christ. This takes time, effort, and a heart change on our part. The work that we've been commanded to put in is a lot. But we carry the responsibility to share the Good News.

So Pray. Invite. And Share His Gospel. And leave the results to Him. But take the first step. Let's be faithful to our call.





- Cathy Boileau met via Zoom to discuss details of Pastor Kurtis' quarter-time placement at State Line UMC and the plans for cooperative ministry between SLUMC and First UMC.
- After discussing finances, the Leadership team voted to pay 1/3 of SLUMC's Shares of Ministry to the Susquehanna Conference before the end of the year. This totals \$5,000.00. Leadership appreciates all the efforts the Conference has made to help us stay open as a church family.
- The nursery team will be reviewing forms and formalizing the process of signing children in and out of the nursery each Sunday for safety.
- Adult Fellowship is planning a Bible-based escape room event. More to come on the date of the event.
