


The group will meet at the church for a light meal and decorating a float for the Greencastle Christmas parade. Please sign-up and bring an appetizer or dessert that is "finger food".

- ALL MEMBERS are encouraged to attend our annual church conference at 4 pm on Nov. 7 with Rev. Chuck Sprenkle presiding. Chuck has worked with our team to navigate the past difficult months, especially prior to Pastor Ruth's appointment.
- Our Shares of Ministry (formerly referred to as Apportionments) have not been paid for the past year as our
 giving has been below the amount needed to meet all needs. Since the two PPP loans granted helped us get
 back on our feet somewhat, the team voted to submit \$5000 of the roughly \$15,000 we are responsible
 for. With our sustained faith and prayers, we trust that God will continue to guide us in these challenging times.
- Pastor Ruth's salary for 2022 was voted on. Pastoral compensation info will be part of the church conference packet.
- Be sure to notice the new look of the recently painted surfaces outdoors including the front entrance and shutters. With the outdoor work done on Oct. 23, our church home has a more inviting appearance.
- The Outreach Team is alive and well! Everyone's support of the food ministry and fudge sale is greatly appreciated. A total of 5 poultry items will be donated to Waynesboro Human Services for Thanksgiving distribution.
