# Without Borders

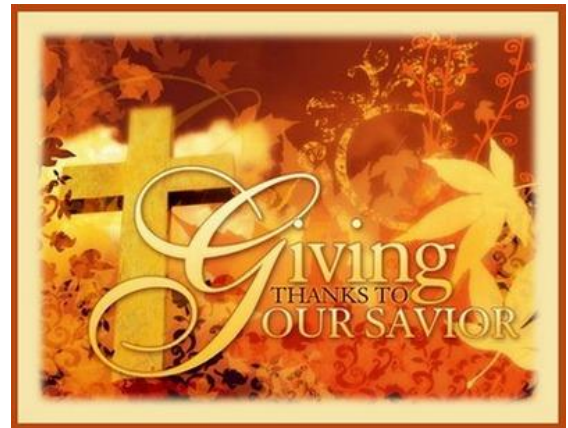
## Psalm 100

and medicine.*

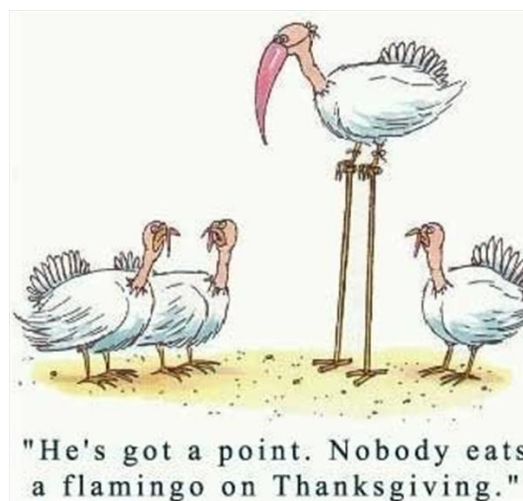
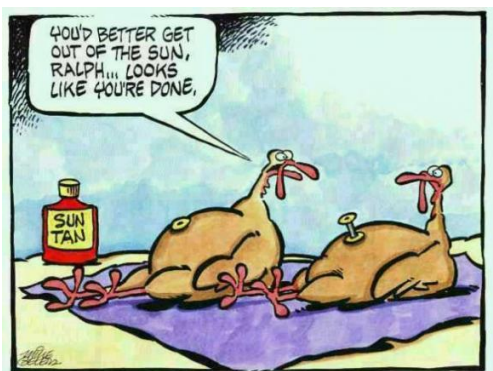
*Thank you for the natural world, in which we find the means to be clothed and
