

On Wednesday evening, 12/2/2020, the church leadership met via online conference call to talk about the Bishop's recommendation to cease all activities in the building at least until January 1st. We feel that this action could be detrimental to the survival of the State Line UMC. At this time we will continue to meet in person for Sunday worship with the understanding that if there is a COVID incident within our congregation, we will reassess returning to online worship. This will be addressed on a week to week basis until further notice.

As of now we will have Christmas Eve service at 7pm with the understanding that masks must stay on and we must social distance from everyone not within our family circle. Please let Pastor Steven or someone on Leadership team know if you are planning to bring people for Christmas Eve service so we can set up extra space to accommodate.

Please be patient and understanding of the procedures that are put in place and do your part to keep everyone safe and healthy.

 Please stay home if there is even a hint of not feeling well, or you have been around someone who is sick.
Hand sanitize as you enter the sanctuary! EVERYONE should use sanitizer as you enter sanctuary.
Keep at least 6 feet away from all others at all times (except family groups of course)
Please exit the building as soon as possible after worship so the space can be sanitized.
Understand that this can change at any time.

### Leadership Team Meeting Highlights

The Leadership Team met Tuesday, November 17, 2020.

- Terry Berkley has agreed to fill the position of Financial Secretary.
- Finances were discussed. We do not have enough funds to meet all monthly obligations. No apportionments have been paid to the Conference for at least 5 months. We are behind by several months on health insurance and pension contributions for the pastor. Focus will be placed on payroll and utility bills.
- Advent classes are being offered but the leadership team will be keeping an eye on the COVID spike and adjusting if necessary.
- An organizer is needed for our Outreach Team. This volunteer would hang flyers, get information to the congregation about the needs of the State Line Inn residents, gather volunteers to pack and deliver food to the Inn, coordinate receiving food deliveries from suppliers as available, and speaking on Sunday asking for volunteers. If you are interested in assuming this position, please speak with Pastor Steven.
- Ed Fiery has patched the roof that was leaking above the Pastor's office.
- In the spring, the handicap entrance sign will be moved to a more visible location and grass seed will be planted.
- Discussed the possibility of selling of the parish house. Market analysis is being done to help make an informed decision.
- Worship assistants are needed to help with the Worship service to include reading scripture, joys and concerns.

The next leadership team meeting is on December 15<sup>th</sup>. All are welcome to attend.
