## Are We Friendly or Welcoming?

Recent studies have shown that the number one reason someone visits a church for the first time is that *they were invited by a friend* to join in worship. Studies also show the number one reason for returning to a church is that *the congregation is welcoming*. Do we really need studies to spread God's message? To make new disciples of Christ? Why not? Studies and data seem cold in the church setting, but intellect and creative problem solving are talents God has given to humans. Why wouldn't we use these talents to understand how to give more people the opportunity to truly know God and his Son, and all the love and hope They offer?

In a 2018 interview with Thom S. Rainer, author of *Becoming a Welcoming Church*, Rainer provides insight to understanding if your church is friendly or truly welcoming. As State Line United is our church home, we may not be able to see our actions from the visitor's perspective. The good news is that a small church has advantages!

- We know who regularly attends, and who is new.
- We can tell when someone has returned for a second or third visit.
- We can connect with visitors on a personal (but not too personal) level.

By having a Hospitality team trained in providing a welcoming experience, we can ALL greet visitors warmly without overwhelming them. Put yourself in their shoes.
